



Middle School Supply List (2026-2027)

Chromebooks will be school-issued. Parents/students will be given an agreement to sign for liability and to acknowledge a replacement fee is required if needed.

**** Please bring all individual supplies on August 11th during Locker Set up and Supplies Day***

**** Lockers will be assigned on August 11th.***

General Supplies

Pencils - 24, #2 pencils or mechanical

Pens - 12, blue or black (no other colors permitted for anything turned in)

Notebook Paper - 2 or more packs of loose-leaf notebook paper, any width

Highlighters - 4 or more, any color

Locker Shelf - to fit inside locker at school (Collapsible wire shelves generally end up in the trash within a couple weeks. Wooden is best and ****HIGHLY**** recommended. See attached sheet for locker dimensions and directions.

Contact paper - 1 clear roll, for covering textbooks and workbooks at home within the first week of school. Often found with cabinet related materials used to cover the inside bottoms of cabinet shelves.

**** Some supplies may be needed during the school year if we run out and an email will be sent home if so.***

**** Students are responsible for their own eating utensils, plates, cups, etc. Microwaves are available.***

**** Snack cart is available through-out the day at designated times.***

Homeroom Supplies (Goes to Homeroom Teacher)

- **Clorox Wipes** - 1 large container
- **Last Name A-K** - 4 square boxes of Kleenex
- **Last Name L-Z** - 2 rolls of paper towels

Optional Supplies

- **Pencil Sharpener** - small handheld

- **Mini White Board for Locker** - for reminders in locker
- **Expo Markers and Eraser** - for locker
- **Sticky Tack or Magnets** - for hanging pictures, etc. in locker (absolutely no tape or stickers allowed)
- **Hand Sanitizer** - personal size for locker

HISTORY (6th & 8th grade)

- 3-Pocket Folders (to fit in notebook)
- One 3-ring binder with notebook paper (8-1/2 x 11)
- 3 erase-able black or blue pens
- 3 green ink pens
- Highlighters, colored markers, and pencils

HISTORY (7th grade)

- One-subject spiral notebook (red)
- Red Folder
- Composition notebook
- One bag of individually wrapped candy

BIBLE (6th 7th 8th)

- Bible - 1 NIV (preferred) *that is left at school (Study Bible recommended)*
- Index cards and case- (memory verse or vocabulary)
- 2 Spiral or Composition Notebook
- 1"-1.5" Binder with dividers (for notes, handouts, and planner)
- Pencils and Pens (black or blue ink only for written work)
- Loose-Leaf Notebook Paper
- Colored Pencils, Markers or Highlighters (for Bible mapping and creative projects)
- 2 Pocket Folders (for homework and handouts):
 - 6th Grade - Green
 - 7th Grade - Blue
 - 8th Grade - Red
- Ruler (for creating timelines or Bible maps)

SPANISH (6th 7th 8th)

- 1 packet of notebook paper (for the classroom)
- 1 Clorox wipes (or Walmart brand) (for the classroom)
- 1 large box of tissues (for the classroom)
- 1 package of colored pencils (to bring for classroom use)

- 1 pocket folder with the following color scheme:

PRE-ALGEBRA (8th grade)

- College ruled 3-subject black notebook and 2-pocket plastic folder

- *2 pack disinfectant wipes or disinfectant spray

ART: (6th)

- 1 2-pack **Paper Mate Flair Felt Tip Pen**, .7mm, **Black**
- 1 roll of paper towel
- 1 sketchbook (5.5" x 8.5") *students may use theirs from last year**

ART: (7th)

- 1 2-pack of **Sharpie Brand Ultra Fine Tip** (small tip size) Permanent Marker
- 1 sketchbook (5.5" x 8.5") *students may use theirs from last year*
- 1 container of sanitizing wipes (like Lysol)

ART: (8th Grade)

- 1 2-pack **Paper Mate Flair Felt Tip Pen**, .7mm, **Black**
- 1 sketchbook (5.5" x 8.5") *students may use theirs from last year **
- 1 pack of **Huggies** Sensitive Baby Wipes

* Only new students will need to purchase a sketchbook (5.5" x 8.5")

MUSIC: (6th-8th Grade)

- 1 black view (clear pocket on front) binder (1" or 1.5" if not able to find)
- 1 highlighter (any color)
- 1 eraser
- **Last Name A-L:** 1 roll of paper towels
- **Last Name M-Z:** 1 container of sanitizing wipes

LOCKER REQUIREMENTS

- * **The school is supplying combination locks this year.** There will be a \$5 replacement fee if a lock is lost.
- * Any non-school issued lock or key lock will be cut off.
- * Please leave valuables at home.
- * Absolutely NO tape on lockers permitted. Cleaning fee if locker requires additional cleaning at end of school year.
- * Please label belongings.

LOCKER DIMENSIONS

- * Overall locker dimensions: Height: 35" / Depth: 16.5" / Width: 12"
- * In the picture below, the boards are not glued together; they are sitting on top of each other.
- * All locker contents, including the shelves, go home with the student at the end of the school year.
- * Shelves can often be cut at Home Depot or Lowes to these dimensions and assembled at school. Currently can be used through 12th grade at SCA.
