## LOCKER DIMENSIONS

* Overall locker dimensions: Height: 35" / Depth: 16.5" / Width: 12"
* In the picture below, the boards are not glued together; they are sitting on top of each other.
* All locker contents, including the shelves, go home with the student at the end of the school year.
*Shelves can often be cut at Home Depot or Lowes to these dimensions and assembled at school.
