

Second Grade Supply List (2023-2024)

<u>Please label the following items with your child's name.</u>

- Easy to read Bible
- 2 boxes of 24-count crayons
- 1 box 12-count Crayola colored pencils
- 2 pink rectangular erasers
- 1 pair of Fiskars scissors (or other child-safe brand)
- $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " plastic pencil box for the desk
- 1 (10 oz.) bottle of hand sanitizer

The following items are for community use and do not need your child's name on them.

- 2 dozen **sharpened** #2 pencils
- 2 large rolls (or 3 small) of paper towels
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 large containers of Clorox (or Lysol) wipes

ART: (2nd Grade)
